



NCCR Evolving Language SNF PhD fellowship in psychology and neuroscience of language and emotion Geneva - Switzerland

A PhD candidate position for four years is available in the National Center of Competence in Research (NCCR) Evolving Language in the work package Emotion Integration at the Neuroscience of Emotion and Affective Dynamics (NEAD) lab at the University of Geneva in the Swiss Center for Affective Sciences and the Psychology department.

The applicants should have a master in Neuroscience or Psychology or equivalent and competencies in linguistic, statistics, and/or neuroimaging including fMRI or/and EEG. The project focuses on the neural processes related to the integration of both prosodic and semantic levels and implies that the applicant should have strong interest in the study of emotion and language with an interest in affective sciences and interdisciplinary approach.

This project is included in the NCCR Evolving Language (https://www.evolvinglanguage.ch/) and associated with the Swiss Center for Affective Sciences (http://www.affective-sciences.org) and the Psychology Department with a full access to the 3T fMRI scanner, EEG systems and virtual platform in the Brain and Behaviour Laboratory (http://bbl.unige.ch/index.html) located in the Geneva Medical Center and in the Campus Biotech (https://www.campusbiotech.ch/). This project will be also in collaboration with Prof. Fruehholz.
